List Description: Two cottages with thatched roofs and
 faced in roughcast (4 occupations).



The northern cottage (see photographs top left and overleaf)
 remains as described in the Provisional List of Buildings of
 Architectural or Historic Interest for Torrington Rural
 District, issued in October 1959. The Southern Cottage (see
 photograph bottom left) is now roofed with asbestos slates
 and is not occupied.

List Description: Inscription on the most west cottage,
"Thomas Hackwill and Thomasine 1724". Cob cottages,
with whitened fronts and thatched roof continuous over
all. 1 storey plus attic which has eye-brow windows.
Buttresses.



The inscription reads "Thomas Hackwill and Thomazin 1724"
(see photograph overleaf). The eastern cottage is now
colour washed in green. Otherwise the building remains
as described above.

List Description:

Stone, cob and thatch house. 2 storeys plus attics. Casement windows. Dining room has open fireplace.

The building is now rendered and the windows have been modernised.
The thatch has been replaced by asbestos slates.

The thatch roof has been replaced with tiles. (Building in background of photograph - see also North Woodtown).

The original farmhouse. Cob and thatch with projecting stone chimney. Cattle bower at one end. Typical Devon farmhouse.

The building is now known as "The Retreat". Part of the rear is of exposed stone, not faced in roughcast (see lower photograph). The front now has a porch with asbestos slates (see upper photograph). The building otherwise remains as described in the Provisional List of Buildings of Architectural or Historic Interest for Torrington Rural District, issued in October, 1959.

List Description: Early C19. Faced in roughcast, with steep slate roof, 2 storeys. Windows with semi-circular heads. 6 panel door with cambered hood.

The building remains as described in the Provisional List of Buildings of Architectural or Historic Interest for Torrington Rural District, issued in October 1959. The occupations are now known as Fairview and Myrtle Cottage.

The building remains as described, except that only one
sliding sash window remains. The remainder have been
modified.

Has slate roofed outbuilding between cottage and street and a porch extension with corrugated asbestos roof (see photograph). The building otherwise remains as described above.

 Casement windows.

The building remains as described above except that the eastern cottage has one sash window, and a tiled extension.

The central cottage has a slate roofed wing projecting
towards road (see photograph). The building is
otherwise as described in the Provisional List of
Buildings of Architectural or Historic Interest for
Torrington Rural District, issued in October, 1959.

Central Doric doorcase with bay windows either side.

The main building remains as described above, but the adjoining eastern wing is roofed with asbestos slates.

A domesday manor. Existing house is built of cob and stone, with brick chimneys and a thatched roof. 2 storeys.

The building remains as described in the Provisional List of Buildings of Architectural or Historic Interest for Torrington Rural District, issued in October 1959. There is also a thatched cob outbuilding, which is shown in the lower photograph.

Faced in rough cast. Long low thatched farmhouse of 2 storeys
with 5 3-light casement windows.

The building is now rendered, and the thatch has been replaced
with asbestos slates. The 3-light casement windows remain.
